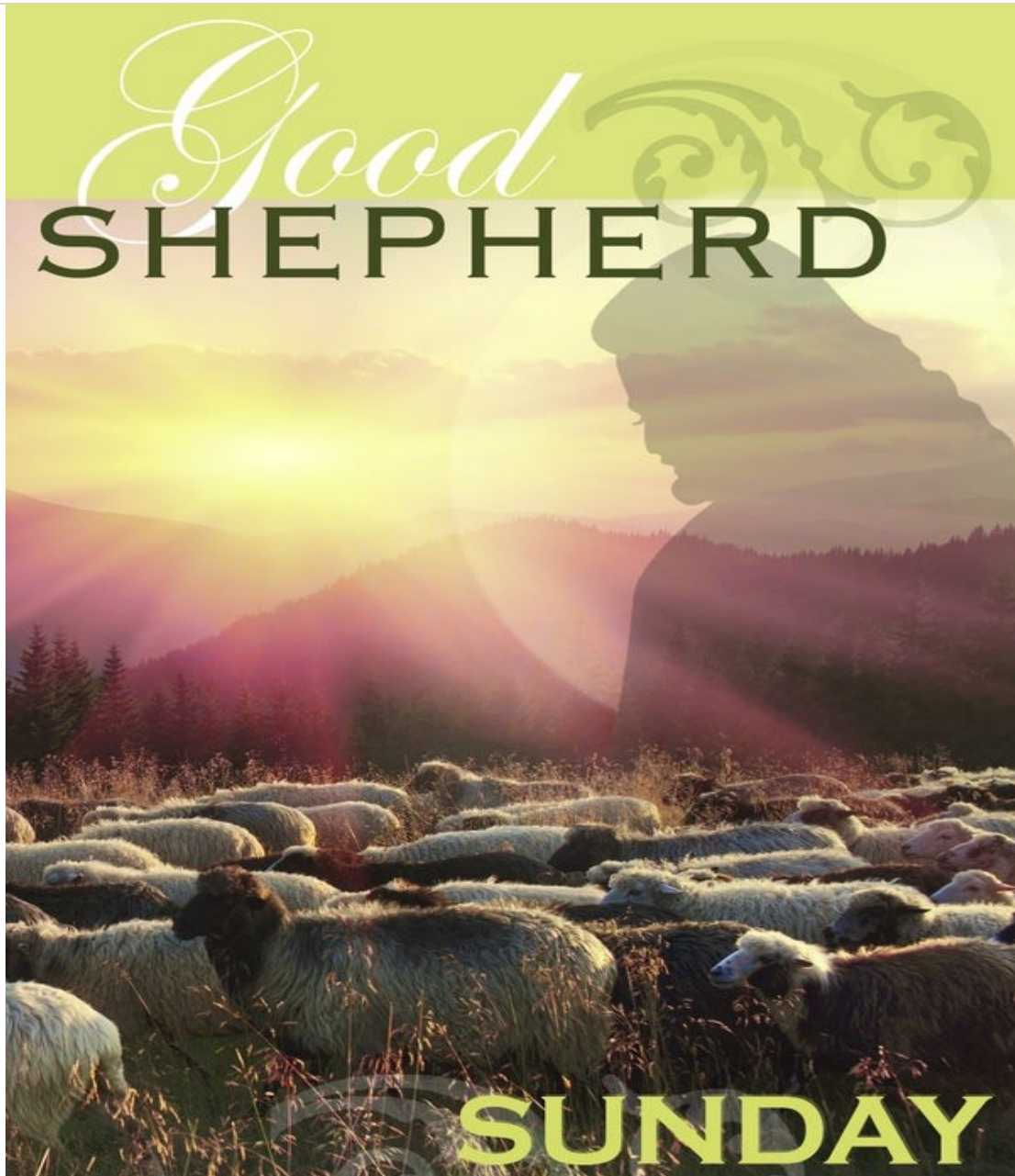

Christ Calls Because We Need Him

Today, on Good Shepherd Sunday, the Church invites us to fix our eyes on Christ, the Good Shepherd. He is the one who knows each of us personally, who seeks us when we are lost, and who leads us with patience and love. This Sunday is also a special moment when priests are invited to share something about their vocation story. I would like to do so from a simple but important perspective: how God, in His mercy, adapts Himself to us in order to invite us to become good shepherds, just as He is the Good Shepherd. Every vocation begins with His initiative, with His loving desire to draw us close to Him.

We often think that following God depends mostly on our effort, as if we had to climb up to reach Him. But in reality, it is God who comes down to us. He meets us where we are, with our limits, our doubts, and even our resistance. In His patience, He lowers Himself to our level so that we can understand Him and experience His call. He does not force us or expect us to have everything figured out. Instead, He speaks to us in the middle of our daily lives, in simple and quiet ways, inviting us step by step to trust Him and to follow Him more closely.

When God calls, He does not do so because He needs anything from us. (Sometimes we think we are doing Him a favor in following His calling!) God lacks nothing. He calls because **WE NEED HIM**, and because we need the path He offers us. The vocation to the priesthood, like every vocation, is not a favor we do for God. It is a gift He gives to us. He calls us because He knows what is best for us. He knows that only by following His will can we find true happiness and grow in holiness. There is no real or lasting happiness without holiness, and His call is always meant to lead us to a full and meaningful life.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, let us ask for the grace to listen more carefully to the voice of Christ, the Good Shepherd, and to follow Him with trust. As we stay close to Him, we learn from His heart and begin to reflect His care for others in our own lives. In this way, each of us, in our own vocation, can become a good shepherd for those around us. Let us also pray in a special way for priestly vocations, that many may hear God's call and have the courage to respond with generosity and faith.

What's a Vocation?

The vocation of every Christian is holiness, but typically, a vocation is the specific call of each one, **a personal call from God to a particular way of life** through which a person is meant to love, serve, and grow in holiness —meaning, **to flourish as a human being, achieving the fullness of his potential**. It is not simply a career choice or a personal preference, but a response to God's plan, who knows each person deeply and calls them for their own good. Every vocation—whether to marriage, the priesthood, religious life, or dedicated single life—**is a path by which a person can become truly happy by becoming holy**. In this sense, a vocation is a gift from God, an invitation to follow Him closely and to live a life of meaning, love, and service according to His will.

To reflect on: Am I aware of what my specific vocation is in the Christian life, and am I living my life accordingly?

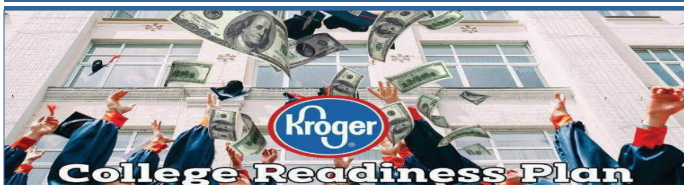
