### God's Love Made Visible

In this Sunday's Gospel, we are reminded that Jesus does not leave us to walk alone. Though He ascended to the Father, His presence remains alive and active among us through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Just as He guided the early Church—strengthening the apostles, inspiring their preaching, and sustaining them through trials—so too does He continue to guide us today. In moments of uncertainty, in decisions both great and small, and even in our struggles, Christ walks with us, gently leading us forward in faith, hope, and love.

The same Spirit that animated the first believers is at work within each of us. We are never abandoned. When we listen in prayer, when we open our hearts to Scripture, and when we live out the teachings of Christ, we allow that divine guidance to shape our lives. The Church itself stands as a living testimony that Jesus continues to shepherd His people. Across generations, cultures, and challenges, His presence endures, inviting us to trust more deeply and to follow more faithfully.

On this day, we also pause to honor our mothers—those who are with us, those who are far away, and those who have gone before us into God's eternal presence. In a very real way, a mother's love reflects the love of God Himself. Through their care, sacrifice, and tenderness, we have experienced something of God's own compassion and faithfulness. Our mothers have often been the first and most beautiful expression of God's love in our lives, a gift given freely and generously by Him.

Let us, therefore, give thanks to God for the gift of our mothers. Let us pray for them, entrusting them to the Lord's care, and ask His blessing upon them always. And in gratitude, may we remember that we are all called to be reunited one day in the fullness of God's Kingdom. Sustained by Christ's presence and guided by the Holy Spirit, we journey forward in hope, confident that love—God's love—will bring us home.

### What is a bishop?

A bishop in the Catholic Church is an ordained minister at the highest level who leads and cares for a large group of Catholics called a diocese (a region made up of many parishes). He is a successor of the Apostles, which means his role continues the mission that Jesus gave to His first followers. He has the fullness of the sacrament of Holy Orders, which means only a bishop can ordain new priests and deacons, and he is the main teacher and shepherd of that larger area. A bishop teaches the faith, celebrates important sacraments like Confirmation and Holy Orders, and guides both priests and the faithful in living a Christian life. He is also responsible for keeping the Church united and faithful to its teachings. Bishops work in communion with the Pope and with other bishops around the world.

**Call to action:** Pray for the bishops (especially for our archbishop) and their intentions as they lead their local dioceses.

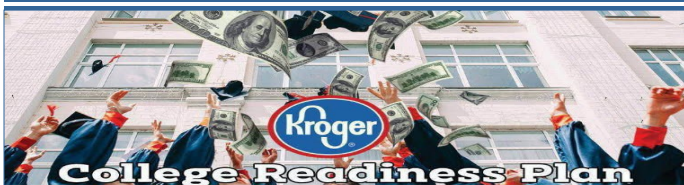
