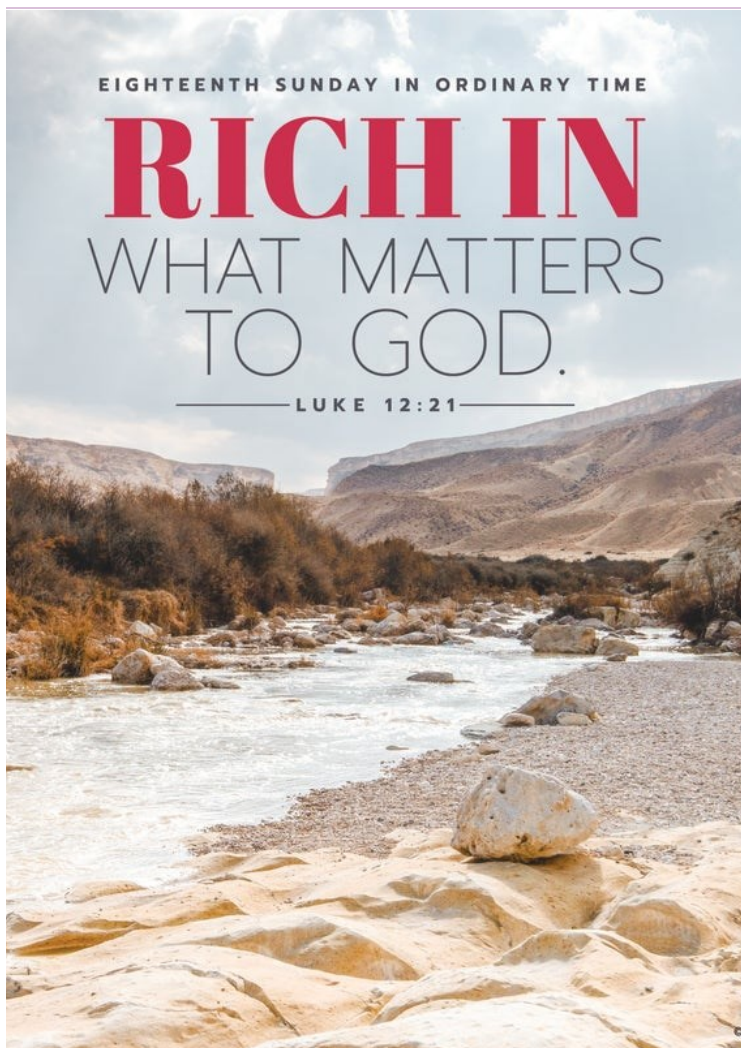

Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God." (Lk 12:21)

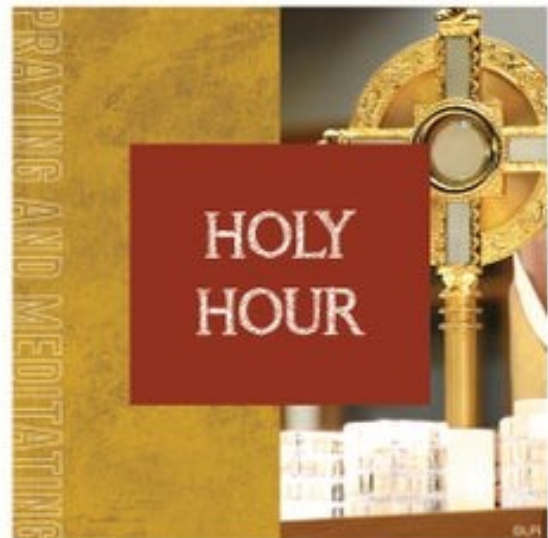
