but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." (Lk 14:11)

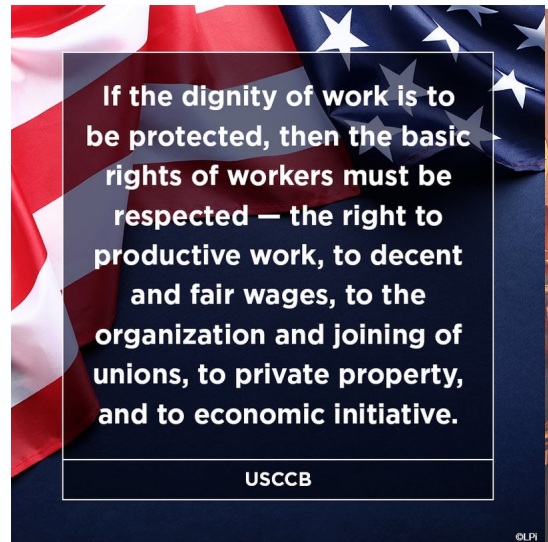

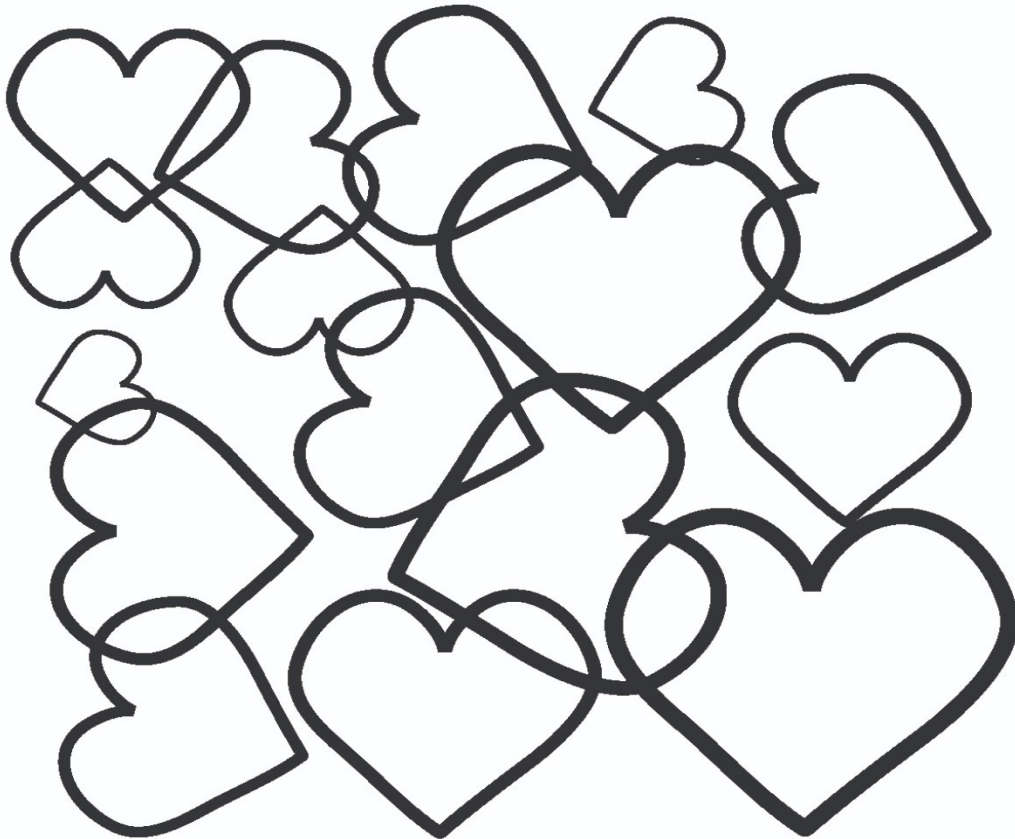
