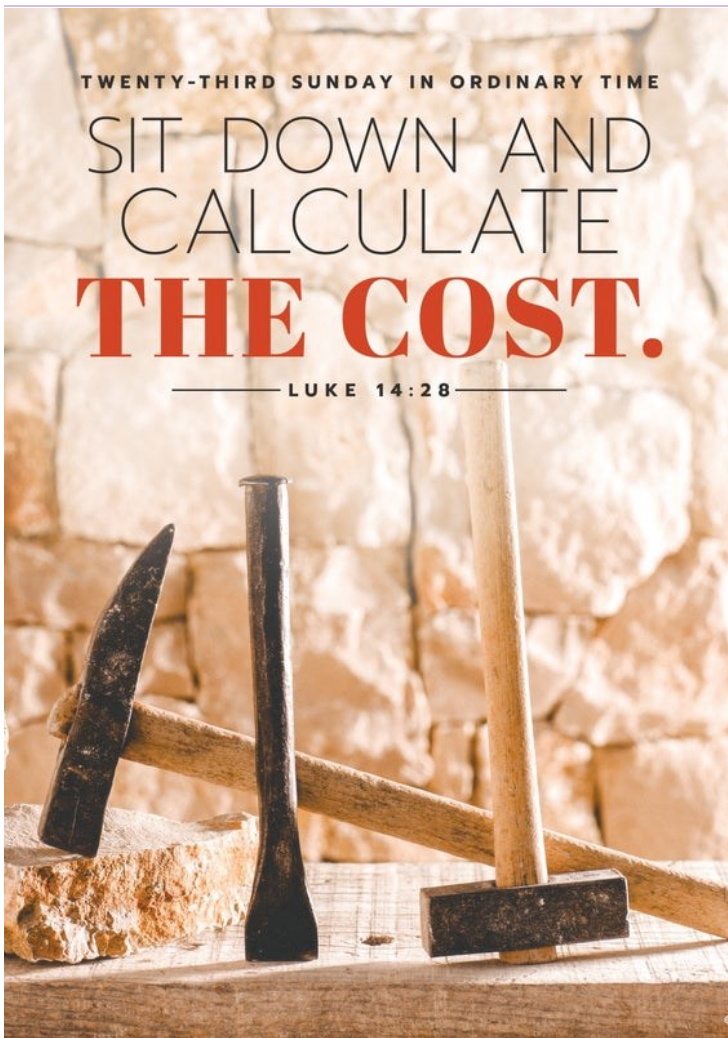

In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge. (Ps 90)

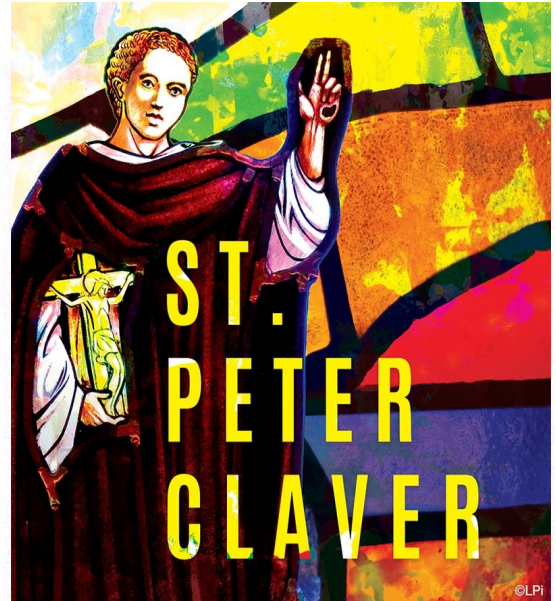
Second Reading:

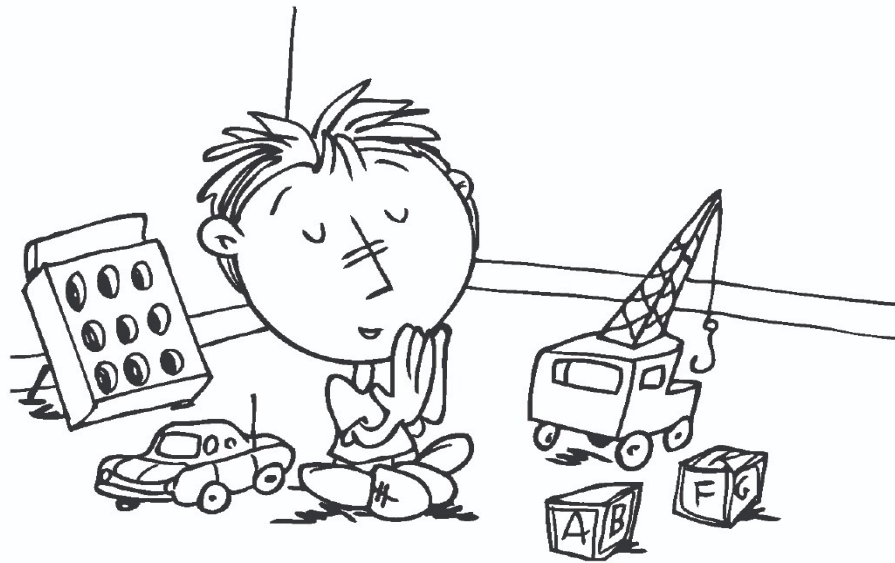
