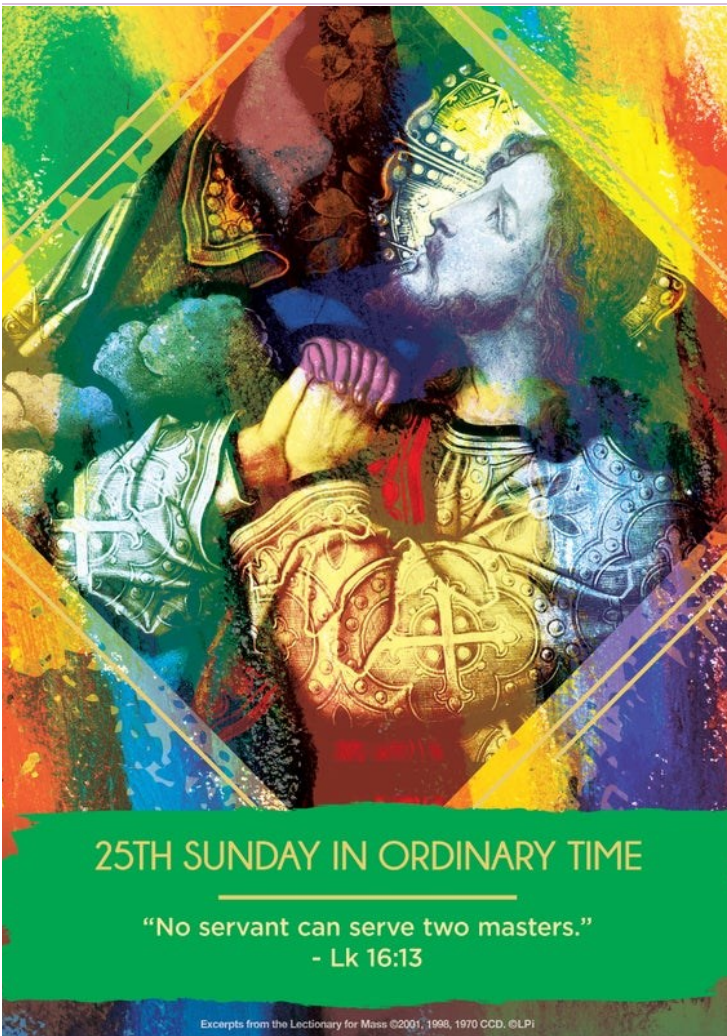

You cannot serve both God and mammon." (Lk 16:13)

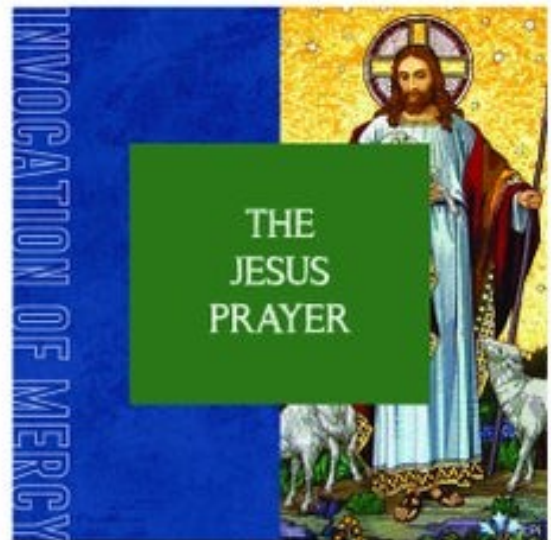

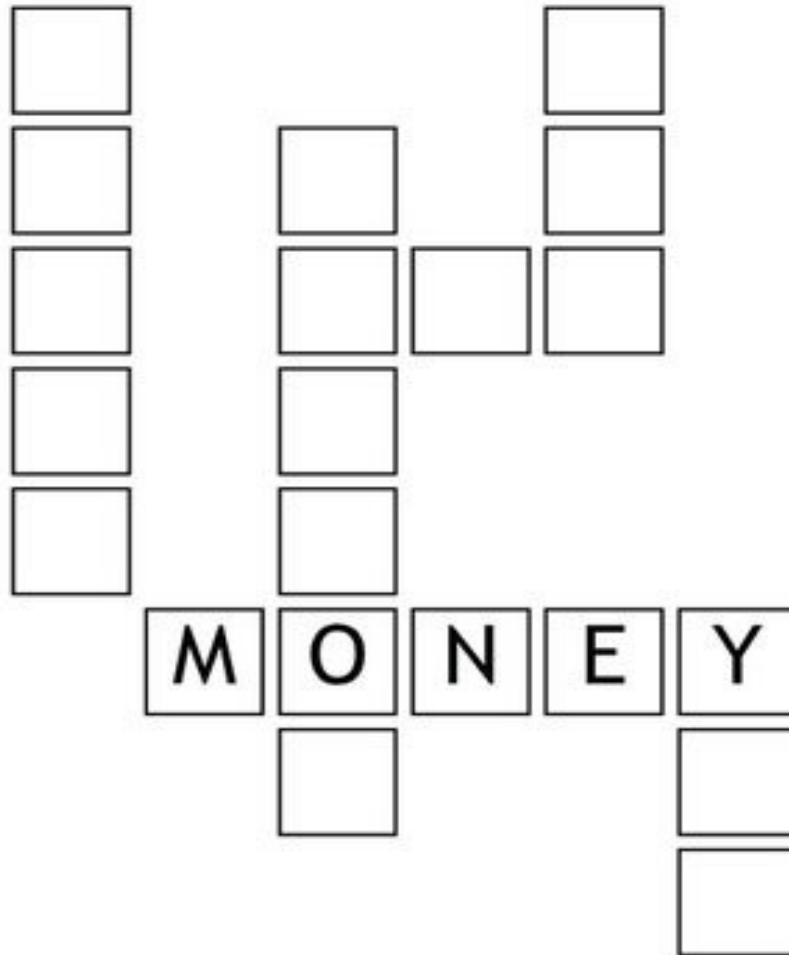


25th Sunday in Ordinary Time • Luke 16:1-13
