# PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS

**October 12, 2025**  
**28th Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
***When God Delays His Response***

Saint Augustine reminds us that prayer is not about trying to change God’s mind, but about allowing God to change our hearts. He says that God already knows what we need before we ask, yet He invites us to pray so that our desire for Him may grow. When we lift our hearts in prayer, we open ourselves to His presence and prepare to receive His blessings with deeper faith and love.

Sometimes, though, it can feel as if God does not answer our prayers, at least right away. Saint Augustine teaches that this waiting is part of God’s loving plan. “By delaying His gift,” he writes, “God increases our desire; by increasing our desire, He expands our soul; and by expanding our soul, He makes it capable of receiving His gift.” In other words, God’s silence is never absence—it is often His way of drawing us closer, helping us learn to trust more fully in His goodness.

In the end, Augustine encourages us to pray not to make God do what we want, but to let Him shape our hearts according to His will. Every prayer, even when it seems unheard, brings us into deeper communion with the One who loves us beyond measure. When we pray with perseverance and faith, as today’s Gospel teach us, we discover that God always responds—sometimes not by giving what we ask for, but by giving us Himself satisfying all the longings of our hearts.

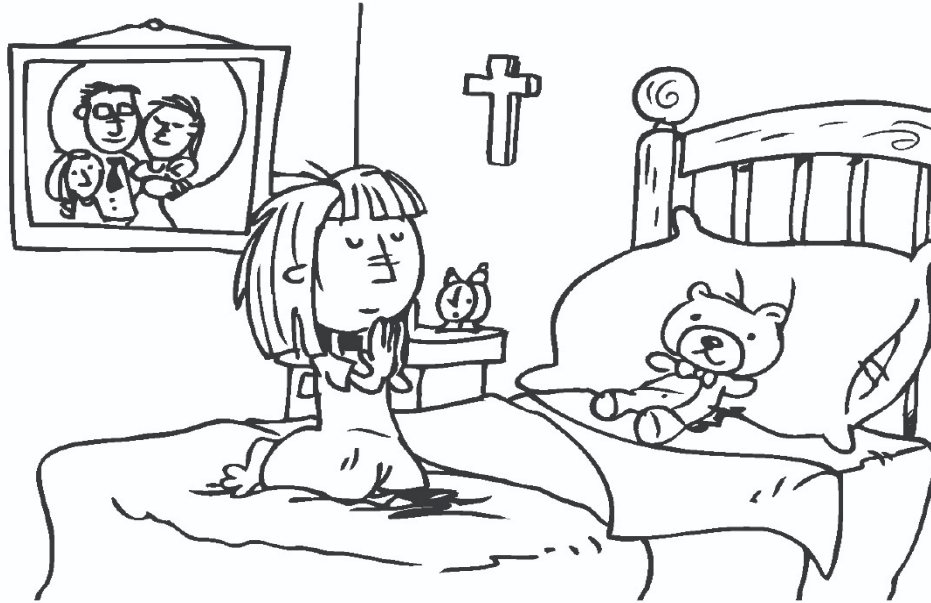
## **Regarding The Society of Our Lady, Queen of all Saints**

Each of us in the Catholic faith community has a responsibility to reduce error, avoid schism, and promote ecclesiastical communion. To that end, the Archdiocese of Detroit shares the following information about a group operating in Southfield and elsewhere called “The Society of Our Lady, Queen of all Saints,” which presents itself as “a group of Catholic clergy offering the traditional sacraments.”

As of August 2025, the group was renting space in The Church of the Redeemer, an Episcopal church in Southfield. Previously, they occupied space in Taylor at the Little Rose Chapel Shrine, which has no affiliation with the Archdiocese of Detroit. An individual identifying himself as clergy from The Society of Our Lady, Queen of all Saints has visited Archdiocesan parishes in the area.

**In the interest of truth and to avoid confusion among the faithful, we must clarify that, as best we are able to tell, **The Society of Our Lady, Queen of all Saints is NOT an organization in ecclesiastical communion with the Catholic Church.** Catholics are advised to avoid association with this group.**

Thank you for your attention to this important matter. Let us pray that God will bring all Christian communities into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church, so that we may all be one. (cf. John 17:21)
