





PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS

November 2, 2025
All Souls' Day

Pray For the Faithful Departed

As we celebrate All Souls' Day, we are invited to broaden our vision of what life truly is. Life is not confined to our time on earth; by God's grace and mercy, it transcends it. Let us live each day with our eyes fixed on the promise of eternal life. Death is not an abyss of emptiness, nor the end of our story — in Christ, it has become the doorway to a life that never ends. The Resurrection of Jesus gives meaning to all our joys and sufferings, revealing that love is stronger than death and that our destiny is eternal communion with the Father.
