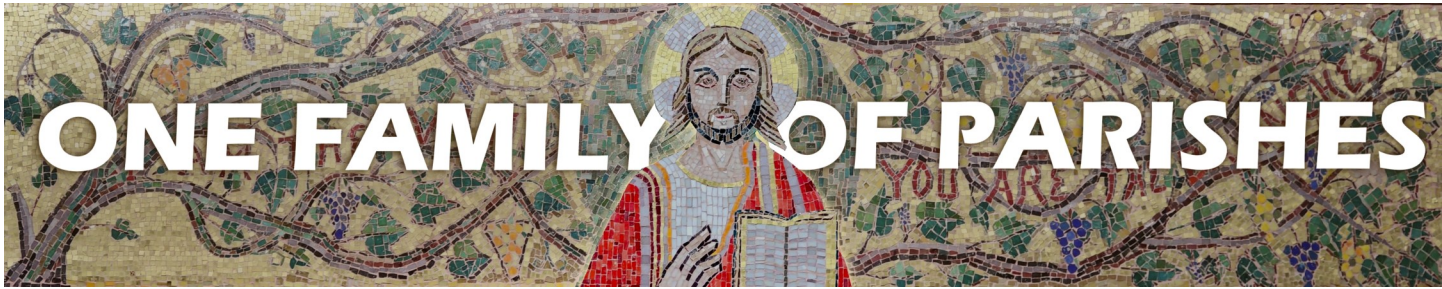

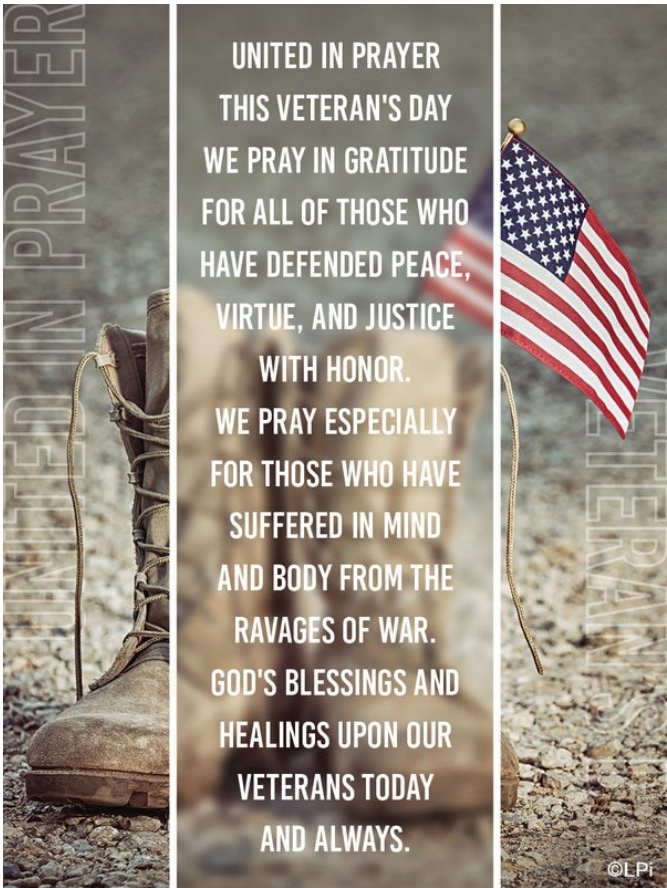

# PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS

November 9, 2025

*The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica*

## Where God Dwells

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica reminds us that God does not dwell in stones or marble alone, but in the hearts of His people. Each of us, by grace, is called to become a **living temple of His presence**. Through baptism and the gift of the Holy Spirit, our very bodies become the dwelling place of God. This calls us to care for ourselves with reverence — in purity, integrity, and love — so that our lives may reflect the holiness of the One who lives within us. The dignity of the human person flows from this divine indwelling: we are not our own, for Christ bought us with his blood on the Cross.

At the same time, we are invited to honor and care for the **visible temple of God**, the church building where we gather. Within its walls, heaven touches earth; in the Eucharist, Christ is truly and substantially present — Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. To care for our church is not a matter of mere maintenance but an act of faith and love. Cleanliness, beauty, and reverence in our places of worship express our awareness of the sacred mystery celebrated there, and the Divine Presence in the Tabernacle.

Let us then renew our gratitude for both temples — the spiritual and the material — through which God continues to dwell among us. May we, like Mary, be “houses of God,” open and docile to His presence, and may our care for our own lives and for the house of prayer mirror our faith in the Real Presence of Christ. In doing so, we become living stones joined together into one Church, holy and radiant, where God is truly glorified.

## What's the Importance of Baptism?

In Baptism, we are freed from sin and reborn as children of God (this doesn't happen by default, nor by our own merits). Through water and the Holy Spirit, we are cleansed of original sin and of personal sin as well and receive the gift of new life in Christ. This sacrament unites us to Jesus' death and Resurrection, making us members of His Body, the Church, and temples of the Holy Spirit. Baptism fills our souls with sanctifying grace without which we cannot be saved, enabling us to live in friendship with God and to grow in faith, hope, and love. It also imprints an indelible spiritual mark that forever identifies us as belonging to Christ, which is why Baptism can never be repeated. As the gateway to the Christian life, it opens the door to the other sacraments and to full participation in the life of the Church.

**To reflect on: Do I acknowledge my dignity as a son or daughter of God? Am I living in accordance with this immense dignity?**

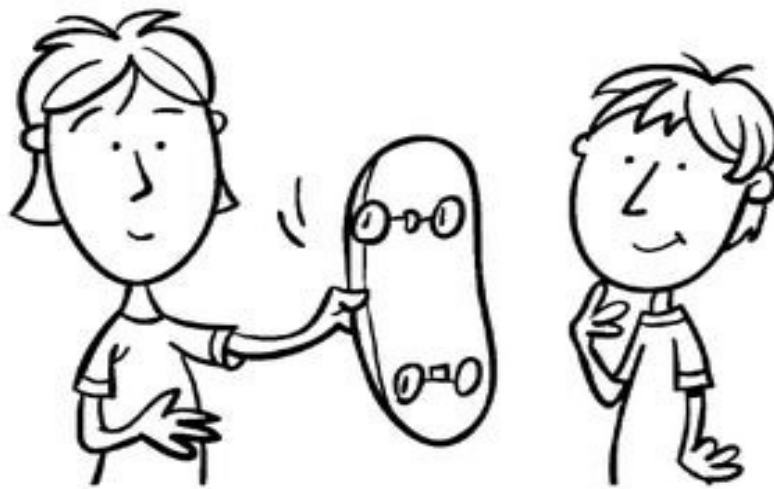
