


Presentation Our Lady Of Victory Parish

"Whoever obeys and teaches these commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven." Jesus presents two paths for us today: we can break his commandments or obey them. And the result corresponds to our choice. If we decide

not to follow God's guidelines, we will not enjoy the fullness of the kingdom of heaven. But if we choose otherwise, eternity will look much brighter for us!

Of course, it's easy to know in our minds what the right choice is. But putting this into practice is another matter. The commandments Jesus gives in today's Gospel are not easy to follow. He takes the ancient Ten Commandments to a deeper level of commitment. He says more than do not kill. Rather, do not even harbor anger in our hearts. He says more than do not commit adultery. Rather, do not even indulge in lustful thoughts. He says more than do not lie. Rather, do not even swear.

Undoubtedly, Jesus is asking us to chart a challenging course. But he would not expect us to follow these directives if it were impossible to do so. And it's important to bear in mind that Jesus doesn't set high standards to test or punish us. His love for us is at the root of everything he teaches us. Following these commandments, challenging though they may be, will *in fact* make us happier people, both now and in eternity! As with so many good things in life, committed effort on our part is necessary—whether it be maintaining good health, accomplishing a certain skill, or earning a sought-after award. ST VINCENT DEPAUL ASSISTANCE

The Society of St. Vincent De Paul is accepting application for the 2016–2017 Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP). Applicants who need help with their light and gas bills and meet the following gualification can apply.

1) Applicant have to be at least 18 years of age.

2) Applicant needs a past due notice

3) Applicants must be a US citizen or gualified alien.

4) Total income in the household is at or below 150% of the federal poverty.

5) Clients enrolled in the LSP program with DTE, the CARE program with Consumers Energy or the MAP program with SEMCO are not eligible for the MEAP.

6) Applicants must have paid at least \$450 for a combined gas and electric or \$225 for one utility bill during the last six months.

CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL Your Gift Makes A Difference Metropolitan Tribunal

Sacramental registers are among the most historical legacies the Catholic Church generates, and parishes must handle them properly. Three record keeping workshops, for those in parishes responsible for maintaining sacramental records, will be held this month.

Archbishop Allen Vigneron promulgated a revised and expanded "Reference Guide to Sacramental Records: Preservation and Policies" in 2010. At the workshops, staff from the Metropolitan Tribunal and Archives Office will cover the care of registers and Sacraments of Initiation, and changes to registers and notations. New record updates will also be available.

The workshops will take place from 1-3 p.m. at St. Alfred Parish, Taylor, on Wednesday, February 15; at St. Hugo of the Hills Parish in Bloomfield Hills, on Thursday, February 23; and at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit on Friday, February 24.
