TRINITY VICARIATE EVANGELIZATION GRANTS

The Evangelization grants previously announced are still available. Initially it was indicated the \$500 grants to assist the vicariates’ parishes with an evangelization project, if needed, could be applied for while developing the parishes budgets.

If your parish did not apply for a grant at that time, you may still apply. An award may be granted once during the church year to assist a Trinity Vicariate parish with an identified evangelization project. The same application process applies.

Please allow 60 days for a determination once the grant request is submitted.
